To access the Brian T. Rusnock Amphitheater, follow Donohoe Road from the traffic light at Westmoreland Mall. At the four way stop, turn left on to George's Station Rd. After crossing the railroad tracks, turn right onto Streetpark Loop.

The Cedar Creek Park Amphitheater is located on Evergreen Drive through the main entrance of the Park. Cedar Creek Park is located in Rostraver Township off Route 51, one-quarter mile north of I-70.
