A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROSTRAVER,
WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
PROHIBITING POSSESSION, SALE, DISPENSING OR DISTRIBUTION OF
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON TOWNSHIP OWNED OR CONTROLLED
RECREATIONAL PROPERTY DURING YOUTH ACTIVITIES;
PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT IN THE ABSENCE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Township of Rostraver owns or is in actual physical care, custody, and control of certain real property, including recreational property; and,

WHEREAS, said recreational property principally involves youth activities; and,

WHEREAS, from time to time adult-only recreational activities may exist at the recreational property; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have carefully determined that the possession, sale, distribution, or dispensing of alcoholic beverages are not consistent with the spirit of recreational facilities when the same deal exclusively in youthful activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board Of Commissioners of the Township of Rostraver that no brewed, malt, distilled or fermented alcoholic beverage as defined by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania through it's Liquor Control Enforcement Rules and Regulations shall be possessed, sold, distributed, or dispensed within any recreational facility owned or under the care, custody, or control of the Township of Rostraver when said activities are utilized for youthful purposes.

BE IT, THEREFORE, FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board Of Commissioners shall accept for review a request for a special permit to possess, sale, dispense, or distribute such beverages when adult-only recreational activities are contemplated. The rules and regulations governing the special permit shall be in conjunction with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Liquor Control Enforcement and the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Rostraver, whose decision on granting or rejecting such a permit shall be final.
