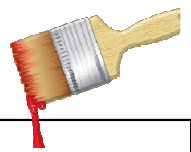


Free Educational Programs

Dried latex paint in cans can be thrown in the trash. Dry latex-paint at home by pouring it over an absorbent substance, such as a clay based cat litter. Once the liquid is absorbed, place in a plastic bag and dispose with your regular trash.
