**RESOLUTION NO. 873**, introduced by George A. Martin, is a Resolution Declaring a Disaster Emergency, was given a reading by Solicitor Maatta.

**DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, investigations made at the direction of the Chairman and the Rostraver Township Commissioners have disclosed that a State of Emergency in Rostraver Township on or about February 6, 2010 at 6:00 a.m. did cause to leave homeless, injured or without essential services, persons residing in Rostraver Township, Westmoreland County.

**WHEREAS**, the State of Emergency has seriously affected the safety, health and welfare of a substantial number of citizens of Rostraver Township, and was of such magnitude or severity to exhaust all local resources and available forces.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Emergency Management Services Code of 1978, Act 1332-323, we do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Rostraver Township.

**FURTHER**, we direct the Rostraver Township Emergency Management Agency to coordinate the activities of the various response agencies and take appropriate action aimed at the alleviation of human suffering and hardship and the restoration of essential public services.

Andrew S. Temoshenka moved Resolution No 873 be adopted as read. Patrick G. Egros seconded the motion. The following yea and nay votes were recorded:
