

B. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35 and costs. Any person exceeding a maximum speed limit by more than five miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2 per mile for each mile in excess of five miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

187-40, Section I-H: Stop Intersections Established.

A. Those intersections listed below which are incorporated by reference into and made a part of this section are established as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected in which a position as to face traffic approaching the second-named street upon the first-named street at each stop intersection, in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection upon the first-named street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323 (b) of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the second-named street until he has followed applicable requirements of that section of the law.

B. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and costs.

187-42, Section I-J: Streets Where Vehicle Weight Limits are in Force.

1. Willow Links Drive	Between SR 0201 and Rosewood Street	26,000 pounds
2. Rosewood Street	Between Willow Links Drive And Cedarwood Drive	26,000 pounds
3. Rosewood Street	Between Willow Links Drive And the end of the Cul-de-sac On Rosewood Street	26,000 pounds
4. West Spring Grove Blvd.	Between a point 642 L.F. West of SR 3025 and West Spring Grove Blvd. intersection with West Spring Grove Blvd.	26,000 pounds

B. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall be prosecuted under Section 4902(a) of the Vehicle Code and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$150 and costs, and an additional penalty of \$75 for each 500 pounds, or part thereof, in excess of 3,000 pounds over the maximum allowable weight as prescribed by Section 4902(e-1) of the Vehicle Code.


